Camp Polk Meadow Preserve

A high desert meadow with Whychus Creek meandering through it. The Preserve has a public interpretive loop for exploring the upper meadow's springs and historic barn. The lower meadow is open for guided walks and provides a variety of wildlife habitats and close look at the Whychus Creek restoration.



Metolius Preserve

A ponderosa pine forest with several forks of Lake Creek flowing through it, the Preserve has a variety of hiking options. The South Fork Kiosk hosts an accessible interpretive loop that tells the story of salmon in Lake Creek. Longer trails lead visitors thoughout the forest and connect to the regional Lake Creek Trail.



Whychus Canyon Preserve

Our newest Preserve with outstanding canyon scenery and access to Whychus Creek. Trails lead visitors along the canyon rim to a bouldered overlook. The more adventurous can take a steep climb down (+ back up!) to find the burbling Whychus Creek.
