

Deschutes Land Trust's Preserve Caretakers Camp Polk Meadow Preserve Caretaker Duties

Camp Polk Meadow Preserve Caretaker (1 person):

Summary: The Camp Polk Meadow Caretaker will volunteer 2-3 days per year from April – October to help maintain and care for the Camp Polk kiosk, signs, benches and bridge in the Hindman Springs public use area. All access is easy and accessible from parking area.

Difficulty: Easy

Level 1 Caretaker Duties:

Inspect and maintain kiosks, signs, benches, and bridges once a season.

- Notify Land Steward of the date that you will be out at the Preserve.
- Check for basic structural integrity and stability of the kiosk.
- Check for sharp edges and/or splintering of the kiosk and two benches.
- Wipe benches and clear weeds and debris from around benches and bridge.
- Check condition of port-o-potty.
- Check informational/interpretive signs for damage and clean with a 1:1 mixture of white vinegar and water followed by a wipe down with water. Complete once in the beginning and once at the end of the warm season.
