

Deschutes Land Trust's Preserve Caretakers Indian Ford Meadow Preserve Caretaker Duties

Indian Ford Meadow Preserve Caretaker (1 person):

Summary: The Indian Ford Meadow Caretaker will volunteer 2-3 days per year from April-October to help maintain and care for the Founders Trail kiosk, interpretive signs, and benches. All access is easy and accessible from parking area.

Difficulty: Easy walking along .5 mile gravel trail.

Level 1 Caretaker Duties:

Inspect and maintain kiosks, signs, and benches once a season.

- Notify Land Steward of the date that you will be out at the Preserve.
- Check for basic structural integrity and stability of the kiosk.
- Check for sharp edges and/or splintering of the kiosk and two benches.
- Wipe benches.
- Check informational/interpretive signs for damage and clean with a 1:1 mixture of white vinegar and water followed by a wipe down with water. Complete once in the beginning and once at the end of the warm season.
