

Deschutes Land Trust Trail Stewards Whychus Canyon Preserve Trail Duties

Whychus Canyon Preserve Trail Stewards (2 people):

Summary: Requires hiking higher mileage (3–7 miles total), and up and down steep slopes. Use of small hand tools, including hand saw, clippers, etc.

Difficulty: Moderately to highly strenuous.

Duties:

- Notify Land Steward of the date that you will be out at the Preserve.
- Hike trails to check overall trail conditions. Clear small debris, branches and trash from trail as needed.
- Identify invasive plants growing near trail and remove (hand-pull), if time allows, and as needed.
- Check gates and oil hinges if needed.
- Check condition of property, trail and directional signs, kiosk, and port-o-potty. Clean trail signs as needed.
- Document unusual flora and fauna sightings.
